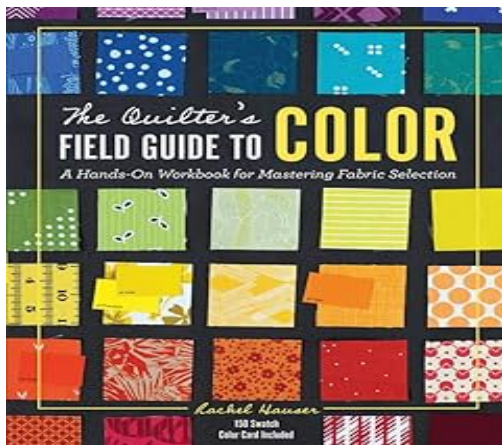


The Quilters Field Guide to Color: A Hands-On Workbook for Mastering Fabric Selection By Rachel Hauser ,

However after seeing all the little rectangles cut up (and you do have to cut them) there is a disproportionate amount of cool colors. Literally dozens upon dozens of blues purples and greens while only a very small portion of warm tones and neutrals.
