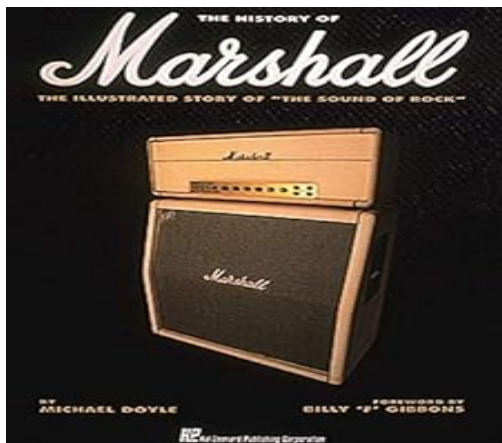


A History of Marshall The Illustrated Story Of The Sound Of Rock book
