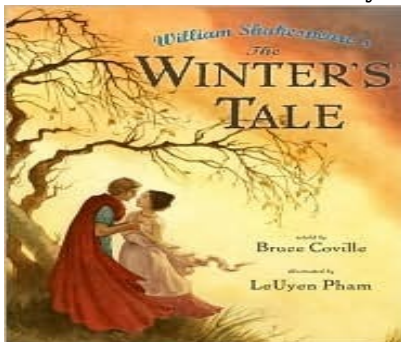

Coville has chosen a Shakespearean tale that's not much performed: **William Shakespeare's Sonnet**.
