I love pop art and could look at books like this all day!Also I able to recognize basically the artist and time period of various incarnations of Catwoman just by looking at the pictures which you know will totally come in handy for the rest of my life:-)It is truly remarkable to me how Catwoman started being drawn by Bob Kane to essentially sex up the comic strip and then now has transformed into the Ed Brubaker version of Catwoman a feminist role model of sorts. Much of its value is in the compiled juxtapositions from comics illustrating the evolution of Catwoman's signature look the continually sexually charged relationship between Catwoman and Batman Catwoman's male minions and their occasional catearred outfits and the various incarnations and origin stories that have accompanied her through comics TV and film. It's quite an overview and especially fun for those of us who didn't follow the comics early enough to experience Catwoman at her campiest--the full halloween style cat mask she wears for a while is hilarious not to mention the eternal dilemma of skirt versus one piece. I had a more in-depth history lesson/biography of the character in mind but this turned out to be more "short sweet and simple;" its a pleasant fast read if you take it for what it is. For someone who isn't very familiar with Catwoman's various origin stories/creation it's definitely an informative quick overview of the "life and times" of this particular femme fatale. You'll get more info from a wiki page if you want a bio this is more of a broad bullet point version of catwoman that's very light hearted in the sense that the panels from various comics are used in a comical/cheesy way. Catwoman's fashions are examined in detail and it interesting to see how they develop (fancy acting across from such as Eartha Kitt as Catwoman - it beggars the thought!) as is her psychology and how she became a kitten with a whip.
